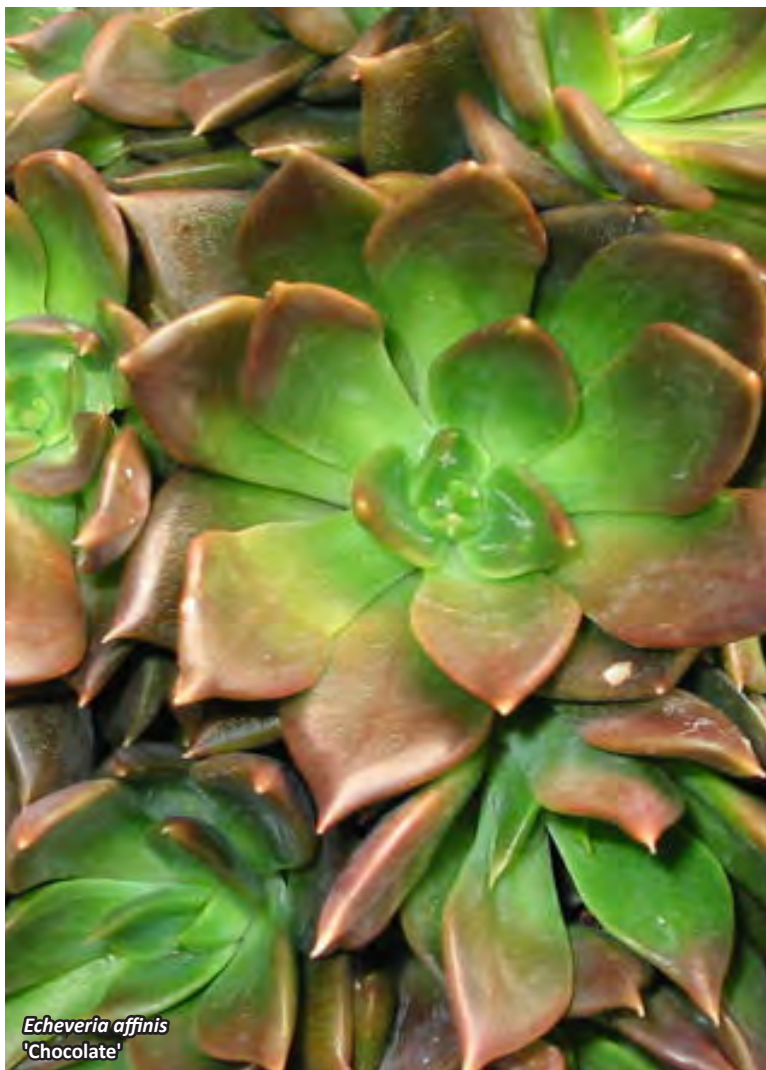

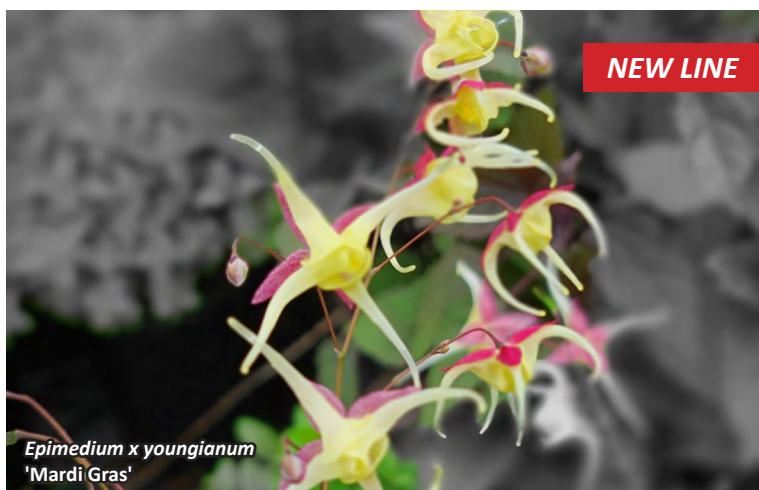

It seems to me to be a silly waste of time and money to try and top aging. The reality is that we should endorse getting older as it generally connects with an increase in wisdom and a better understanding of what is important in life. Most indigenous peoples or traditional communities show a respect for the elders in their societies. They seem to have an unspoken acceptance that the elder generation has knowledge that is worth learning. They know that physically they are stronger than their elders but morally not.

It is sad to see that our society doesn't seem to reflect these attitudes. The older generation (and I think I might be one of them) has so much to give in both understanding of plant growth and experience to know that plant fashions come in cycles. In my forty years in the industry I have seen some great plants people come and go. I feel the better for having known them and the sadder knowing they have passed.

We all need to look around us and see who has knowledge that we all need to share. Take time to talk and question them. Take time to learn what they are already forgetting. Finally take time to connect their knowledge with yours and apply it to the modern world. Most of all take time to ensure their knowledge isn't lost to the trade.

We must stop focusing on how little time we have left and how fast it is moving and instead look at what we know and how do we ensure it is recorded and passed on. Knowledge and age are great things to celebrate. I often wish that some of those clever old folk were still around to help us all understand what is happening around us.

Unlike many other industries we are seasonal and how the plants behave this year may be more like 2008 or 1994 or even before. This means that age and experience have a much greater role than most industries. So, like we should look at apprentices as an investment in the future we should also take the industry elders as a similar investment. We must not let their accumulated knowledge and wisdom get lost.

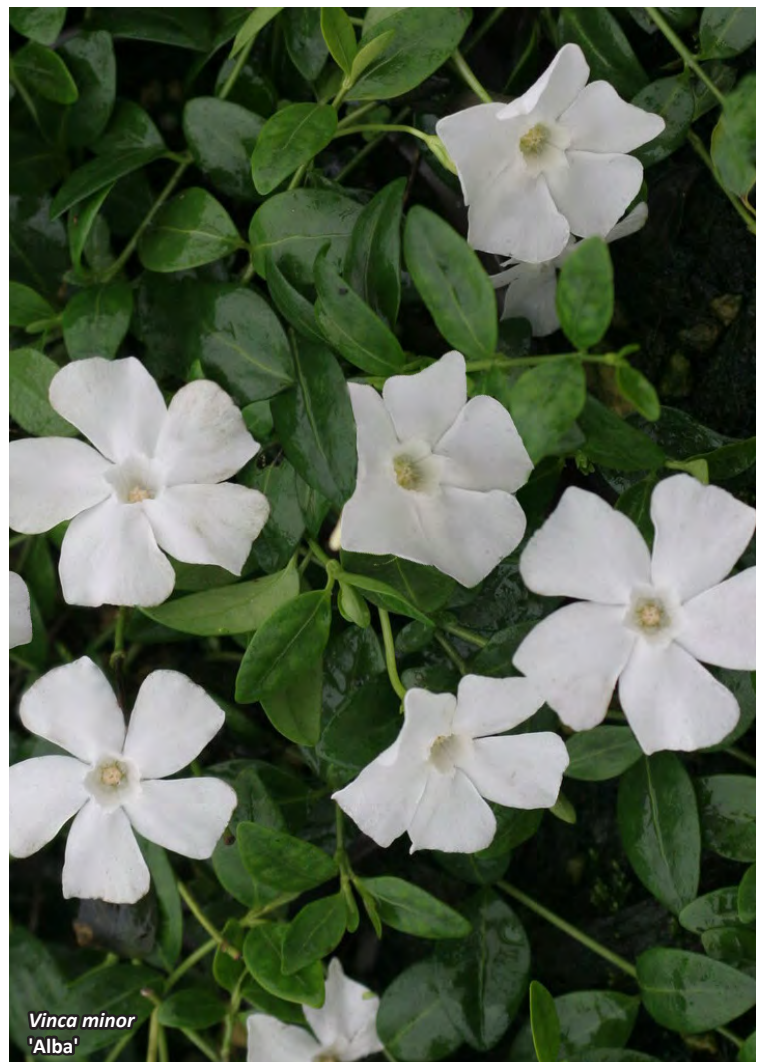
