Clive's Comments

The year rolls on and after a mild early summer most of the southern states have had a bloody hot January. WA and SA have had some temperatures that make nursery work hard. Victoria hasn't had the same level of heat but after several mild summers it has come as a bit of a shock. The Victorian weather has also had some nasty winds that have done major damage and knocked out the power for days.

The loss of power infrastructure has raised the whole debate on renewable energy and its reliability. Some say the loss would not of happened if we hadn't shut down the coal generators. Some say this has nothing to do with it. The problem is who to believe and while we keep debating it we keep moving down the path of renewables without really ensuring continuity of supply.

There wouldn't be a power user who would not prefer renewable power if it was nearly the same price and as secure as fossil fuels. However our power bill has nearly doubled and we have around 100 panels. It is really not good enough to say we are going to get to net zero and "trust us there will be plenty of affordable power". They say that renewables are the cheapest source of power – so why are charges going up all the time? I recently heard that 34% of the population is in support of nuclear and 26% against so perhaps now is the time for a serious, objective discussion on nuclear power for Australia...

Clive's Comments continued...

...Victoria has shown its wisdom in banning new gas connections. It is also discussing banning repairs and replacements to current ga infrastructure. We live in suburban Melbourne – admittedly on the edge – and we would lose power at least six times a year. Sometimes for as little as a few hours and sometimes for a few days. We have an LPG gas stove and hot water which means we can cook food, heat water and have showers. All of these would not be available if we were 100% electricity. Secondly in our street we have around 80amps of power available for each property. Our nursery uses most of this in winter. We can't get more because the street only has 2 phases and with the seven houses we are at our limit. What will happen if we all want to use electric heating in winter?

I don't believe we have enough power to convert all new houses and any aging houses to electricity. The rest of the world sees natural gas as a relatively clean and efficient fuel. Why don't we!! The rush to tell the world that we are heading to zero emissions is costing jobs and the normal comforts we have become used to having in a wealthy and modern country. It is time we start having open public discussions on the cost of this aim and the benefits. Stop governing by ideology and start understanding what the people of Australia want and need.

Now that interest rates have stopped going up they may start coming down and then the community will start to spend. Plant sales have been down over summer. Hopefully there is a pent up demand that will turn into a great autumn.

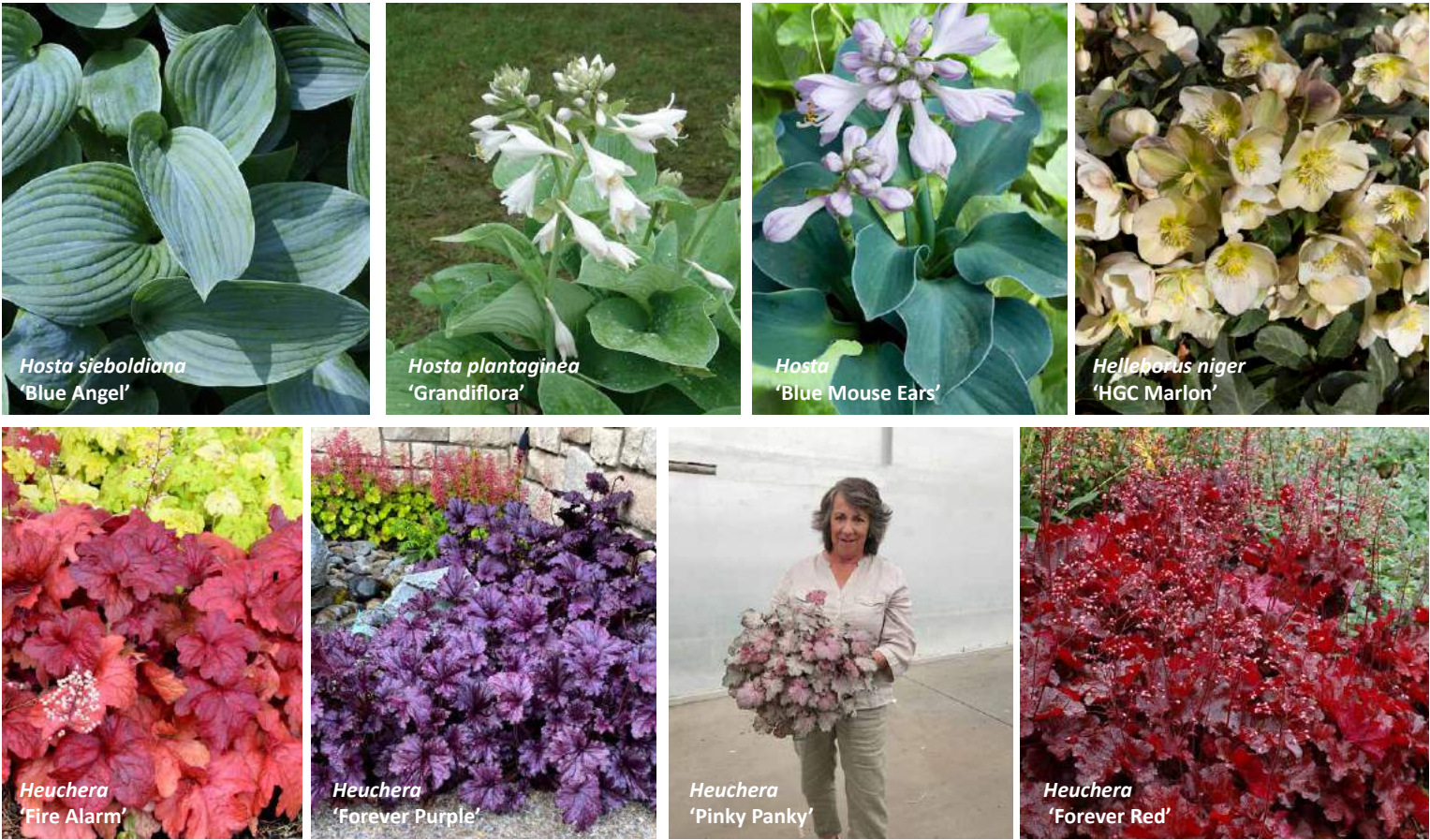
