Clive's Comments

Last month was a busy month with an IPPS International trip to NZ over late April and early May followed by IPPS Australia conference in Cairns. This was our 53rd Australian conference and as usual provided a great opportunity for the exchange of information on Plant growth and production. We changed our name in 2024 from International Plant Propagators' Society to International Plant Production Society. This was driven by a range of members is USA with the aim to expand our membership and influence to the wider horticultural community.

As a Society we are (I believe) unique in our stated motto to seek and share knowledge on plant production across the world. The aim to seek and share knowledge is a rare policy in trade based bodies but if we do not do this our industry is doomed to struggle with staff and understanding of plants. I have seen many real special plants people pass on over the last twenty years. Many of them have taken a lifetime of knowledge, experience and understanding with them. I worry that this trend will continue and we are in danger of losing real, hard earned knowledge. The sort of understanding that only comes from years or working, researching, trialing and thinking about how plants grow and how to grow them.

We talk about climate change being the biggest threat to horticulture over the next decade or two but the problems associated with increasing temperatures are tiny compared to the loss of experience and understanding.....

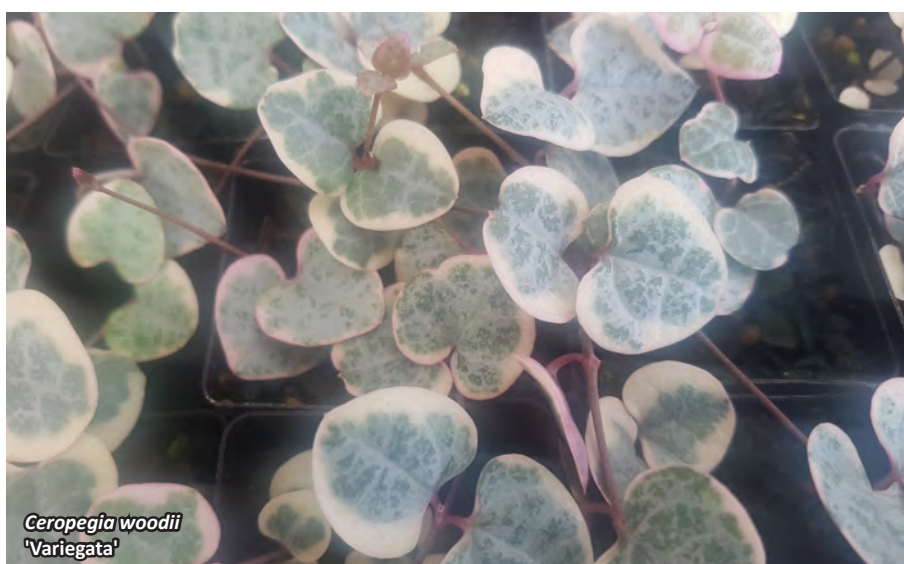
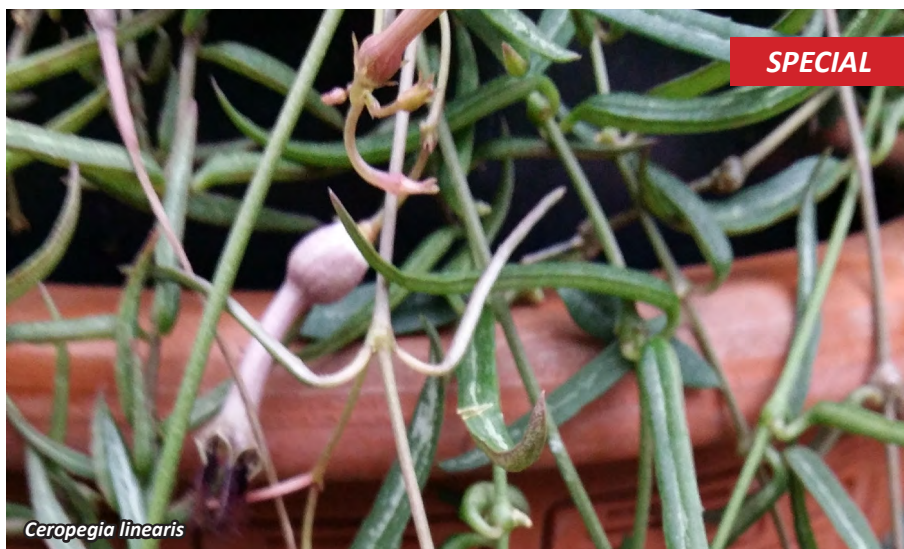

Clive's Comments continued...

....The big box retailers are shrinking the range of plants in the retail space and the expansion of the internet and use of AI is reducing the ability of young and new growers to really understand the plants they are working with. Try using AI to research some rare or old plants and what it comes up with goes from completely wrong to vague and inconsistent. Ring one of those nurserymen who have had a lifetime growing their chosen range of plants and the answers are thought out, accurate and based on facts.

In many ways IPPS is part of the solution. This year we had a wide range of attendees from 20ish to late seventies. People completely new to plant growing and those with lifetimes of learning. The exchange of knowledge between all there was great to see. We had some world experts on old and new fields of study as speakers and attendees. The exchange was bidirectional with the old hands learning from the new. Sometimes a stray question from a new entrant can spark a whole new thought process or change a previous held belief,

To the old farts in horticulture, please pass on your knowledge at any and every opportunity and to the young folk please ask questions and try to understand what is happening as your plants grow. To all of us please think about what and why a plant grows where and how it does. If we can transfer the earned knowledge to all around us and we can think and analyse what we know and learn then our industry can only grow.

It has been a hard autumn/winter for small businesses and nurseries are no exception. They have had to deal with financial pressures from all sides especially those set and generated through government decisions. At each turn costs have gone up, regulation has increased and opportunities have lessened. Nurseries have also had to deal with; tough weather conditions from Victorian drought to NSW floods meant that demand has been much lower than normal. Those of us who have been around for a decade or two know that times will improve if we can manage the stresses. The problem is for many the desire is not there. Retirement is looking good, especially for those on valuable land subject to criminal levels of taxation.

Sounds a bit pessimistic but it isn't. We just need to understand what is happening in horticulture and work to ensure that what we lose is manageable and that our next generation of horticulturalists can continue to build a wide and thorough understanding of plants and how, when and where they grow. So consider joining IPPS and helping achieve a wide exchange of plant knowledge across the generations. Be part of an informed and knowledgeable industry.

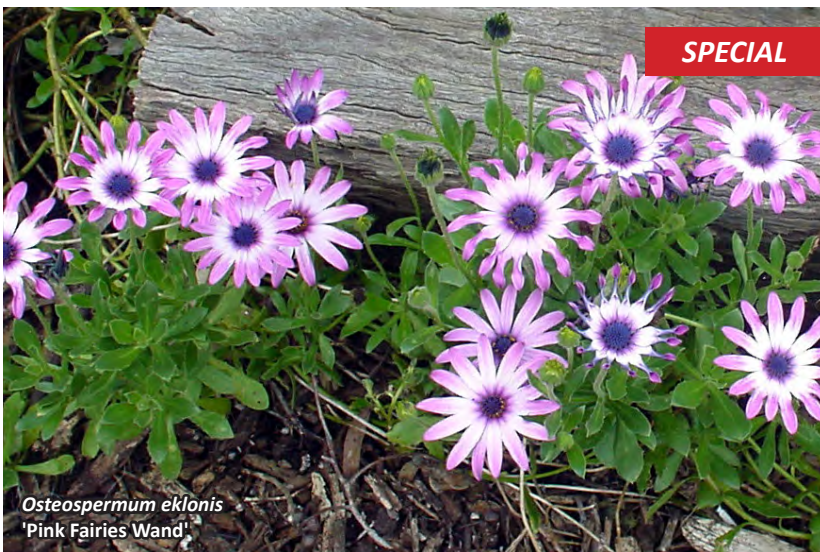

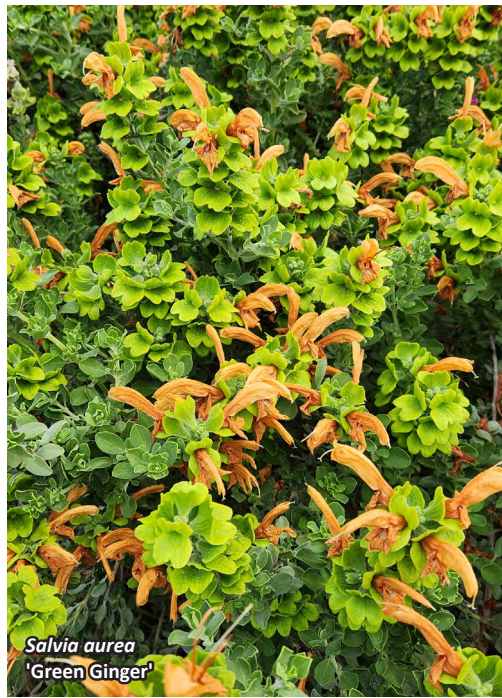

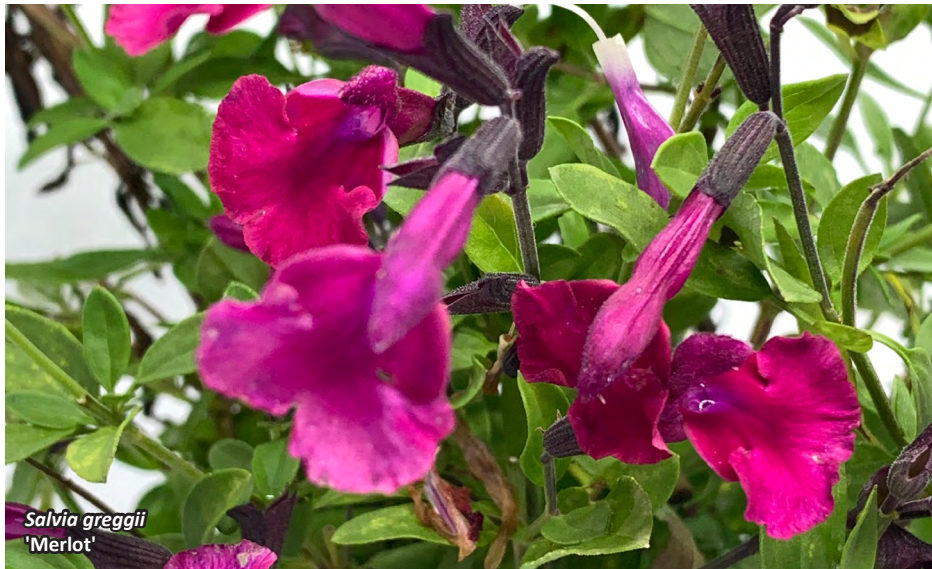
